**Duration: 3 Days** 

## **Prerequisite:**

Delegates should have an understanding of project management but knowledge of PRINCE2 is not required.

## **Course Description:**

PRINCE2 is a method for managing projects. It helps you work out who should be involved and what they will be responsible for. This course conforms to the PRINCE2 7th Edition syllabus.
